

A new automated CPM (Cancer Program Management) Accredidation Report has been developed to provide valuable insights into data related to the Optimal Resources for Cancer Care 2020 Standards 4.4 and 5.1-5.8.

For Standards 4.4, 5.1, and 5.2, the reports are generated using data entered in the Chart Audit section of the CPM module.

For the CoC Surgical Standards 5.3 through 5.8, the reports are generated using data from the coded surgical data fields to determine if the case meets the criteria for the standard, and uses the answers from the CPM Chart Audit screen to determine concordance. (See note on page 2)

## **Accessing the Accreditation Reports**

Navigate to the Enhanced Reporting Module in CRStar. Open the Accreditation Reports from the main menu and then open CPM Reports:






The CPM report settings default to all hospitals, all years, and all standards. Use the filtering options to select a single or multiple hospitals, and to designate a date range.

Use the checkboxes to include suspense cases if desired, and to include a patient list with your final report.

Select ALL Standards or limit the report by checking just the ones to include.
